1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that they be given a certificate approving their practical ability as well as technical knowledge to be appointed as boiler attendant.

2. In reply, the respondents have submitted that for adjudging the said competency of the candidates, the candidates were called by the experts and they were asked questions so as to ascertain their capability to work as boiler attendant.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the rules as envisaged under the Boiler Attendant Rules, 2011 were followed so as to ask the oral questions from the candidates to adjudge their competency to be certified as boiler attendant and keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the experts did not find the petitioners competent enough to be certified as

Boiler attendant hence, the claim of the petitioners as raised in the present

petition is liable to the rejected.

4. Keeping in view the reply filed by the respondents coupled with the Boiler Attendant Rules, 2011 as cited hereinbefore once, the experts found that the petitioners cannot be certified as boiler attendant keeping in view their competency, this Court being not an expert to adjudge the same so as to interfere in the opinion of the experts.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noticed hereinbefore, no interference is called for by this Court and the present writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
