1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.0105 dated 19.05.2023, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has compromised the matter with the alleged victims in the present case and three compromise deeds have been filed before this Court and the same are taken on record.
3. Mr. Ankush Rampal, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and he has no objection, in case the concession of bail is granted to the petitioner, by this Court.

4. Even learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of this, the interim order dated 07.08.2023, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
