Prayer in the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for directing the respondents to handover the possession of Plot No.1183, Sector-64, Faridabad to the petitioner.

2. The stand of the respondents in the written statement filed is that an alternative Plot bearing No.1866-P, Sector-64, Faridabad was allotted on 19.02.2008 (Annexure R-5) on the same terms and conditions and possession was also offered. It has also been mentioned that vide communication dated 27.04.2018, the petitioner had been intimated that he should deposit ₹9,53,433/- which were due including enhancement along with interest in respect of the plot.

3. Counsel for the petitioner admits that the amount has been deposited.

4. Keeping in view the above, we are of the considered opinion that the matter has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
