1. The petitioner, through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking setting aside of order dated 17.09.2011 (Annexure P-4) whereby petitioner has been dismissed from service and order dated 14.12.2011 (Annexure P-5) whereby appellate authority has dismissed appeal of the petitioner.
 2. Mr. Amit Arora, learned counsel for the respondent, at the outset, submits that petitioner has remedy to file revision before the competent authority against the appellate order dated 14.12.2011.
