The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.93 dated 02.06.2023, registered under Sections 336, 342, 380, 365 ad 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion on 21.07.2023, the following contentions were noticed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was initially registered against unknown person and the petitioner had no connection with the allegations levelled in the FIR. It has been alleged that on 04.06.2023, supplementary statement of the complainant was recorded, wherein, he got recorded that as per his inquiry, even the petitioner was involved in the present crime. Learned counsel further submits that the matter between the parties has been resolved and the respondent No.2/complainant Shalinder Kumar filed an affidavit (Annexure P-2) in this regard”.

Today, Mr. Prikshit Thakur, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the respondent/complainant by filing his power of attorney and submits that the matter has been resolved between the parties and the complainant Shalinder Kumar has already filed an affidavit (Annexure P-2) with regard to the compromise between the parties.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the complainant, the interim order dated 21.07.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
