1. Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.57 dated 26.03.2023, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 Arms Act, 1959.
2. Vide order dated 21.07.2023 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 21.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prabhjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.07.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
