Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed on behalf of the petitioners seeking quashing of Complaint No.369/2 (Annexure P-1), filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, as well as order dated 12.04.2006 (Annexure P-3), passed by the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jagadhari, whereby the petitioners herein were summoned throughailable warrants, including all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous inasmuch as Complaint No.369/2 (Annexure P-1), under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, filed

before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jagadhari, stands withdrawn, in view of the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, which fact is also not disputed by learned counsel appearing for the respondent.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
