Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing the notice dated 24.05.2023 whereby the warrant of arrest of the petitioner has been issued by respondent No.3.

It has been submitted by counsel for the petitioner that loan of Rs.4,30,298/-was sanctioned in favour of the petitioner on 24.01.1992. He submits that petitioner has paid Rs.3,31,531/- till date. He submits that the Truck for which the loan was sanctioned has also been auctioned by the respondents. He further submits that petitioner is 81 years old citizen and he is ready to pay Rs.1,00,000/- within a week and he may be allowed to appear before the respondent-authorities.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

In view of the undertaking given by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would pay Rs.1,00,000/- within seven days, operation

of the impugned notice dated 24.05.2023 would remain stayed. Petitioner is directed to appear before respondent No.3 and deposit Rs.1,00,000/- within a period of one week from today and on his doing so, he will be permitted to join proceedings which will be decided as per law. In case the petitioner fails to comply with the above direction, then this order would be of no avail to him and the order dated 24.05.2023 would come in force.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
