1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 18.01.2018 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner and also to implement the order dated 31.05.2011 (Annexure P-2) whereby compensation from all the occupants in possession of cultivable land of village Kapurgarh, Tehsil Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, was ordered to be collected.

2. It has been contended by learned senior counsel that the Department of Revenue issued a letter dated 26.10.1989 which is annexed with this petition as Annexure P-1. He submits that in pursuance of the same, the Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Collector Agrarian, Amloh passed an order dated 31.05.2011 (Annexure P-2) on the quasi judicial side. It is submitted that the order passed is in favour of the petitioner and thus the same should have been implemented by the respondent-State. He submits

that after the said order having been passed, neither there is any amendment nor there is any further challenge to the same and, thus it has attained finality. It is also submitted that the letter dated 22.06.2012 (Annexure R-1) is also not applicable to the case of the petitioner. However, he submits that a number of representations have been filed by the petitioner for the implementation of the order dated 31.05.2011 but no action has been taken till date. It is again submitted that one such representation dated 18.01.2018 (Annexure P-6) is also pending consideration till date before the learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab.

3. Learned State counsel though has opposed the submissions made by learned senior counsel for the petitioner, but he has submitted that the representation dated 18.01.2018 is yet to be considered.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the representation dated 18.01.2018 filed by the petitioner for redressal of his grievance is pending before the Financial Commissioner but has not been decided till date.

5. Thus, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Financial Commissioner, Punjab to decide the representation dated 18.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner keeping in view the submissions made by learned senior counsel for the petitioners before this Court in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
