The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.109 dated 30.05.2023 under Sections 61 (added later on) 68/1/2014 and Sections 420 (added later on) and Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Ranjit Avenue District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 21.07.2023 and 18.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 21.07.2023 and 18.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 21.07.2023 is made absolute.
