HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Ashwani Mudgal) has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ, order or direction in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of notification dated 16.11.2016 (Annexure P-14), regarding conducting of examination for the post of Senior Residents in G.M.C.H. and notification dated 10.11.2016 (Annexure P-15), with regard to conducting of examination for the post of Senior Residents in P.G.I.M.E.R. A further prayer has been made on behalf

of the petitioner to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the qualifying list prepared by G.M.C.H. and P.G.I.M.E.R for the post of Senior Residents in the last examination held by G.M.C.H. and P.G.I.M.E.R on 27.06.2016 and 20.06.2016, respectively.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other legal remedies for seeking compensation, if so advised.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
