1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reconsider the claim of the petitioner by providing employment to him under Dam Oustees Quota of Shahpurkandi Dam Project in terms of the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme Policy dated 18.11.1993 (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently he has not challenged the order/minutes dated 11.08.2022/04.10.2021 (Annexure P-7) vide which the claim of the petitioner has been rejected and thus, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the said order and after giving full and better particulars.
3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
