JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and today, the matter is fixed before the Trial Court, Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that prosecution is delaying the matter.

On being confronted with this fact, learned State counsel as well learned counsel for complainant would submit that there is no delay on the part of prosecution. All the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and it is upto the petitioner to lead his evidence

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with a prayer that Trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 17.06.2021 and all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined, the Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and not to adjourn the matter on the request of the prosecution.
