Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that there has been non-compliance of the order dated 31.08.2023, vide which the petitioner had been directed to join investigation. While drawing the attention of this Court to paragraph No.7 of the petition, it has been submitted that false averments had been made therein that the petitioner was a first time offender and had no criminal antecedents. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is involved in a couple of other criminal cases.

In the circumstances, it is evident that the petitioner has not approached this Court with clean hands; he thus, does not deserve the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail. The petition stands dismissed.
