The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 11.03.2016, vide which, while allowing the writ petition, it was directed that the respondent will consider case of petitioner D.N. Sharma (since deceased) to the post of Manager Grade-II w.e.f. 27.11.1980 and further promotion as Manager Grade-I w.e.f. 10.09.1992 with all consequential benefits.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation Ltd., Panchkula is on record, in which it is stated that vide order dated 17.02.2020, necessary compliance has been made.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record photocopy of the affidavit of Manish Kumar, Bharat Bhushan and Rajneesh Kumar, all sons of D.N. Sharma, in which it is stated that they are only legal heirs of Davinder Nath Sharma and have received the amount towards the claim of their father, who died on 22.11.2019. It is further stated that their mother Smt. Shankuntla Devi also died on 03.09.2019. Learned counsel has further placed on record cheques and receipts issued by all the legal heirs regarding receiving of amount. Photocopies of the affidavit, cheques and receipt are taken on record as Mark 'X' (colly.).

In view of the above, the order dated 11.03.2016 stands complied with. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
