1. Petitioner (Karaj Singh) has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside impugned award dated 03.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Amritsar, whereby the reference regarding reinstatement of the petitioner in service with full back wages was decided against the petitioner-workman. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service with full back wages.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on 09.05.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“There is no representation on behalf of the parties.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 07.12.2022.

However, no further adjournment shall be granted.

*Let the intimation regarding the next date of hearing be
given to the counsel for the parties.*

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of the connected case.”

3. Thereafter, when the matter was taken up for hearing on 04.08.2023 then the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner(s) seeks an accommodation on the ground that the arguing counsel is in some personal difficulty.

*At his request, adjourned to 20.10.2023, subject to the payment of cost of Rs.2,000/- in favour of “**Punjab and Haryana Court Employees Welfare Association (SBI Account No.37167209613)**”.*

Photocopy of this order be placed on the file of above mentioned connected case.”

4. As per office report, no receipt with regard to depositing of cost of Rs.2,000/- in terms of the aforesaid order dated 04.08.2023 has been filed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

7. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
