The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.49 dated 26.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 148, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Roopnagar.

2. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that compromise has already been effected amongst the parties. Quashing petition bearing No.CRM-M-29390-2023 has already been filed in which parties have been directed by this Court vide order dated 02.06.2023 to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded. Copy of order dated 02.06.2023 is Annexure P-3 and copy of compromise is Annexure P-2. Learned counsel further contends that co-accused Gurmukh Singh has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 26.07.2023 passed in CRM-M-34999-2023.

3. Learned State counsel has appeared in view of the advance

notice and placed on record custody certificate as per which petitioner is in custody for the last 01 month and 29 days.

4. Having regard to the compromise Annexure P-2 and the order dated 02.06.2023 passed in CRM-M-29390-2023 (Annexure P-3) and also the fact that co-accused has already been allowed bail but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
