1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to decide Legal Notice dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) which is followed by reminder dated 24.02.2021 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner served respondent-Corporation for 22 years. The petitioner was terminated from services. The petitioner applied for terminal retiral benefits. The petitioner has been paid a meager amount of Rs.1 lakh despite 22 years service. The petitioner has served Legal Notice dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) which was followed by notice dated 24.02.2021 (Annexure P-3), however, respondent has not paid heed to those notices.

3. Mr. Sudhir Nar, Senior Panel Counsel who on advance notice is present in Court submits that competent authority would look

into the notices of the petitioner and would pass appropriate order.

4. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the respondent No.3 is directed to decide Legal Notice dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and notice dated 24.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within 6 weeks from today.
