Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to award one mark to him for correctly attempting question No.97 in the written test held for the post of Technical Assistant in Punjab Warehousing Corporation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner has secured 49.25 marks and even if 1.25 marks are awarded to him, he would not reach the merit position of the last selected candidate, who has secured 51.25 marks.

The above fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, petition is dismissed as rendered infructuous.
