In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, main case is taken on Board today itself for final disposal, which is listed for hearing on 10.04.2023.

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble the Supreme Court, ***Hero Motocorp Ltd. Vs. Union of India and others***, 2022 SCC Online SC 1436, the matter be disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner in

expeditious manner. Further, they have also referred to cases of M/s Inox Leisure Limited whereby the department had already considered their representation in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in ***Hero Motocorp Ltd's*** case cited ***(supra)*** and final recommendation letter dated 25.05.2021, Annexure P-4, for an amount of Rs.24,46,300/- has been sanctioned in favour of M/s Inox Leisure Limited.

Keeping in view the above facts, which are not being disputed by learned State counsel, at this stage, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner, Annexure P-4 dated 22.01.2018 in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in ***Hero Motocorp Ltd's*** case cited ***(supra)*** within a period of four weeks'.
