1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 in case FIR No.58 dated 11.06.2020 under Sections 15 and 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.
