1. Present transfer application, under Section 24 CPC, has been filed by the applicant-wife, for seeking transfer of the petition bearing No. HMA/1227/2023, filed by the respondent–husband, under Section 13 (1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “Sukhwinder Singh Vs. Rukmani Rani”, presently pending in the Court of learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, to any Court of competent jurisdiction at Ferozepur.

2. After issuing notice of motion by this Court vide order dated 04.09.2023, respondent appeared and learned trial Court was directed to adjourn the case beyond the date fixed before this Court.

3. As per office report, letter No. 489 dated 18.09.2023 has been received from learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, wherein it is informed that the respondent-Sukhwinder Singh has already withdrawn the said divorce petition by suffering a statement on 06.09.2023. It has also been informed that the order dated 04.09.2023 passed by this Court in regard to the issuance of direction for adjourning the case was conveyed vide Endorsement No. 9244-H dated 14.09.2023 and prior to that the petition had been withdrawn by the respondent.
