The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.683 dated 15.08.2020 under Sections 406, 420 IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 201 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station City Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 31.10.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajender submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 31.10.2022, a recovery of cash amount is to be effected from him.

It is quite apparent that for the purposes of recovery of cash, custodial interrogation cannot be granted.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 31.10.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
