JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, at the outset, submits
that petitioner has secured 48.22 marks and last selected candidate
secured 46.63 marks still petitioner could not be selected because he is
dependent upon ex-serviceman whereas posts reserved for ex-serviceman
stand occupied by ex-serviceman. The dependents of ex-serviceman are
entitled to reservation, if posts can not be filled from candidates who
themselves are ex-serviceman.
2. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed
his inability to controvert the aforesaid facts.
3. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition
stands disposed of.
