1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case which is now stated to be listed for 02.11.2023 to today.

CWP-25246-2016 (O&M) and CM-8094-CWP-2023

This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 24.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab-respondent No.1, whereby revision petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since, the matter has been compromised between the parties, thus, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the main writ petition and with respect to the same, he has filed an application bearing No.CM-8094-CWP-2023 for withdrawal of main writ petition which is duly supported by an affidavit. 3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances as well as prayer made in the application bearing No.CM-8094-CWP-2023, the same is allowed.
