The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 3 to enquire into the matter and decide the representation dated 22.03.2022 (Annexure P-1)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that feeling aggrieved by the acts of respondent Nos. 5 & 6, the petitioner had moved the representation dated 22.03.2022, Annexure P-1, to respondent No.3 for taking appropriate legal action but till date no legal action has been taken. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if directions will be issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits of the petition, the petition is hereby disposed of

with the direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa, to consider and decide the representation dated 22.03.2022, Annexure P-1, expeditiously in accordance with law. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.

6. It is however, made clear that any observation made above shall not affect the merits of the case nor the same will influence the concerned authority in deciding the representation in accordance with law.
