Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.969 dated 22.09.2018 registered under Section 20, Rule 61 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar, Hisar, Haryana, who is in custody since his arrest on 22.09.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, but prays for a direction for expediting the trial, which is pending for last more than three years.

At this stage, learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Pardeep has stated that in all there are fifteen prosecution witnesses and so far six witnesses have been examined and the case is now coming up before the trial Court for recording prosecution witnesses on 23.01.2023.

In view of above limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, it is

ordered that the trial Court shall expedite and conclude the trial, preferably up to 31.05.2023.
