Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the notice sent to respondent No. 2, taken dasti, which has been received back with the report of 'refusal'.

2. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance to the order dated 25.07.2023, the petitioner has already appeared in the Trial Court and furnished the requisite bail bonds on 29.07.2023. He has placed on record copy of the order dated 29.07.2023 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, the same is taken on record and Marked as Annexure A-1.

3. Heard.

4. By way of instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a complaint case bearing

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No. COMI/974/2018 dated 06.12.2018 titled ‘*Balbir Kaur vs. Paramjit Singh and another*’, wherein he has been summoned to face the trial, as stated above. Notice of the petition was sent to respondent No.2-complainant of the case but he refused to accept service.

5. It is evident from the record that in compliance to the order dated 25.07.2023, the petitioner had surrendered in the Trial Court; has furnished the requisite bail bonds on 29.07.2023. As the petitioner has already appeared before the Trial Court to face the trial, in the aforesaid complaint case, no further action is required in the present petition. As a consequence, interim bail granted vide order dated 25.07.2023 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
