Prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.190 dated 12.10.2022 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in spite of specific directions issued by this Court on 25.07.2023 and 18.10.2023, the petitioner has failed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation. Apart from that, nine other FIRs including one case under NDPS Act have also been registered against the present petitioner.

Consequently, in the considered opinion of the Court, the petitioner is not entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail by this Court. The petition is accordingly, dismissed.
