The petitioner by way of this Writ Petition challenges the order of his posting dated 17.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) from one Range to another Block within the same District.

In the opinion of the Court, the transfer has to be essentially from one District to another District and not postings within the same District. Even otherwise, the reason for posting of the petitioner, as sought in the present petition, is the health ground of his wife, whose treatment is not affected by the posting within the same District.

Learned counsel further alleges malafide against respondent No.4. However, this Court finds that respondent No.4 is not an authority who can transfer the petitioner. Since, it is a posting order, as already discussed hereinabove, no interference is warranted.

The Writ Petition is wholly frivolous and the same is dismissed *in limine* with cost of ₹5,000/- to be deposited with the High Court Legal Services Committee.
