By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.113 dated 02.06.2023 registered under Sections 420, 120-B, 506 IPC (Sections 419, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on) at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of Pavneet Singh, as per which he has been duped of ₹34 lacs by petitioner Avneesh Singh and others on the pretext of providing him visa for Poland and Portugal.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that out of alleged duped amount of ₹34 lacs, he has already returned an amount of 33,98,000/- to the complainant Pavneet Singh.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Mr. Vishnu Dutt, Advocate appears for the complainant and filed his Power of Attorney.

Learned counsel for the complainant concedes that

complainant has already received an amount of ₹33,98,000/- from the petitioner.

As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State Counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last one month and he is not involved in any other case.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
