1. Through this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.97 dated 28.05.2023, registered under Sections 21 (b) and 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur. The earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn.
2. Vide order dated 25.07.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 25.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.07.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
