Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner is claiming the grant of compassionate assistance after the death of his father, who was working with the Haryana Police.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, submits that the services of the father of the petitioner were terminated, which action was challenged by filing CWP No. 4843 of 2009, wherein, the termination order was stayed and as the father of the petitioner was only continuing in service under the interim orders of the Court till the termination order is set-aside by the competent court of law, the petitioner cannot claim the benefit of compassionate assistance.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to revive the present petition or to file a fresh one, in case any right subsists with the petitioner after the decision of CWP No. 4843 of 2009.
