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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. After arguing the matter at length, learned counsel for the appellants submits that he does not press the present appeal at this stage and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the State to dispose of the appellants' regular inquiry, initiated by the State against the alleged misconduct/embezzlement on their part, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, submits that he has no objection to the acceptance of the afore alternate plea made on behalf of the appellants.

3. In the light of the above and because no prejudice is caused to either party on the issuance of a direction for early disposal of a pending *lis* as also because every litigant has a right to early disposal of any proceedings pending against him/her, especially when the State has not raised any objection, the present appeal is disposed of with a direction to the State to finalize the appellants' regular inquiry already initiated under

Section 20 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 within six weeks from today, in accordance with law.
