Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated
16.09.2021 (Annexure P-9) whereby an Ad hoc Committee had been

constituted by respondent No.4 to manage the affairs of the petitioner Association.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Handball Federation of India i.e. respondent No.3 contends that the order dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-9) had been issued by respondent No.4 without any valid authority and that it would have no objection in case the said order is set aside. He further contends that an Administrator has already been appointed by this Court in CWP No.6549-2021, to conduct elections to the Executive Committee of the Punjab Handball Association and even the Handball Federation of India i.e. respondent No.3 has no objection to the aforesaid appointment of Administrator to conduct elections to the Punjab Handball Association.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-the Punjab Handball Association thus does not press the instant petition in view of the above statement made on behalf of Handball Federation of India i.e. respondent No.3 withdrawing the order dated 16.09.2021 and also in view of the order having been passed in CWP No.6549-2021.

Disposed of as not pressed.
