The present petition is for issuance of necessary/appropriate/requisite directions to the official respondents to conduct fair, proper and impartial investigation in FIR No.0043, dated 24.11.2021, under Sections 120-B, 376, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, District Nuh (Mewat), Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the official respondents are not investigating in the said FIR, despite the fact, that the petitioner is ready to get a DNA test, the investigation is not going in the right manner.

Per contra, learned State counsel has filed a status report and has submitted that during the course of investigation, the medico legal examination of the complainant has been conducted and the site plan of the place of occurrence has been prepared and the statement of the complainant

under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has already been recorded. He further submits that the petitioner is evading his arrest since 20.12.2021, and despite various raids, he is absconding. He submits that despite best efforts, it has been reported that the said house is locked and the petitioner is not coming forward for the proceedings.

In the light of the above, no direction is required to be issued.

The present petition is dismissed.
