The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 3, 12 (5) and (11) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner to enable him to perform the necessary tasks and to meet with his family, by considering his application dated 03.07.2023 (Annexure P-1) and the application, vide which parole case of the petitioner has been initiated vide dispatched No. 4687-90 dated 25.04.2023.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on his representation dated 03.07.2023 (Annexure P-1) within a time frame.

respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.
