By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, petitioners have prayed for quashing of order dated 10.07.2023 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot in case arising out of FIR No.438 dated 06.12.2020 registered under Sections 447/379/511/506/149 IPC at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot, vide which bail of the petitioners has been cancelled and they have been ordered to be summoned through warrants of arrest.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners were on bail and were regularly appearing before the trial Court. Due to floods in the area, they could not appear before the trial Court on 10.07.2023, due to which their bail had been cancelled. Learned counsel further contends that they are ready to surrender before the trial Court.

This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to both the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court on or before 22.08.2023, the date already fixed thereat. On their such appearance, the trial Court shall be at liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C and

after disposal thereof, shall admit the petitioners to bail.

If in the meantime, petitioners are sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest against them, they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
