This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent no.2 and other police officials to stop the multiple inquiries in FIR no.285 dated 14.11.2021 got registered by the petitioner under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Nagar, Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, has submitted that in the present case, challan/report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted on 17.06.2023 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of but prays that the State be bound by the statement made before this Court.
