The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.173 dated 02.10.2021 registered under Sections 307, 452, 506, 427, 323, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 25.09.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have entered into a compromise/settlement dated 30.10.2023 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 16.08.2023, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
