1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of General Diary No.025 dated 13.05.2016, registered for offences under Sections 324, 341, 342, 427, 148 and 149, IPC in FIR No.0027 dated 13.05.2016, registered for offences under Sections 341, 323, 148 and 149, IPC at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 18.07.2019, Annexure P-2 and affidavit dated 31.05.2019, Annexure P-3.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the private parties.
3. Similar was the position on the previous occasion.
4. Report has been received from the Trial Court. In the absence of some of the parties to the compromise, Trial Court has reported that it is not in a position to give any opinion regarding the genuineness of the compromise.
5. It seems that because of this reason, parties are not interested in pursuing the matter.
6. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
