This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by appellate authority, thereby affirming the order dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2, allowing the application filed by respondent No.3-Bhagwan Dass and ordered eviction of petitioners from the house in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that respondent No.3 (father-in-law) has died during pendency of the writ petition and after his demise, the subject property has devolved upon his son i.e. husband of petitioner No.1 by way of natural succession. He further states that since
