On 24.08.2022, while issuing notice of motion, following
order was passed:-

“Apprehending their arrest in FIR No.187 dated 24.07.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 506, 34, 324 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, the petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that matter has been amicably settled between the parties in terms of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, Assistant AG Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Mr. VPS Mithewal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 to 4, filed Vakalatnama and admits the fact that compromise has been effected between the parties.

In view of the above, in the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioners shall join the investigation. They shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

To come up on 14.12.2022.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 24.08.2022, the petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.
4. Consequently, the interim order dated 24.08.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
5. Petition stands disposed off.
