Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.60 dated 21.6.2019 registered under Sections 326-A IPC at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed whereby the interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation on the ground that as per medical record, superficial burns to the extent of 13.5% were found on the body of the victim and further, the matter is stated to be compromised between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Singh has not

refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has again reiterated that now the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and that the complainant is having no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 5.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
