No ground is made out for review as reliance had been placed upon the judgment passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in CWP-6173-2011 titled *Bhupinder Batra Vs. Union of India & others*, while allowing the writ petitioner.

Position was the same in that case that on the date of the application, the weightage system was not in vogue and could not have been applied. It is on that basis, reconsideration has been directed vide the order which has now been sought to be reviewed dated 14.07.2022. We do not find any irregularity or illegality in the order as what is proposed by the counsel would amount to negating the relief which has been granted to the writ petitioner and would run counter to the judgment which was of the Co-ordinate Bench which had been relied upon.

Even otherwise, the order was dictated in open Court and the earlier counsel for the applicants was present and no objection had been raised. Resultantly, an effort has been made to re-argue the matter by engaging a fresh counsel, which is not within the scope of review. The present review petition is accordingly, dismissed.
