The primary grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that the amount, which has been paid in excess by the predecessor-in-interest of the petitioner and received by the Estate Manager, Housing Board, Haryana, Panchkula – respondent No.2, has not been disclosed or released to the petitioner, who is now the owner of the flat. Representations have been submitted by the petitioner but without any response. Even a legal notice dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-7), as served upon the Estate Manager, Housing Board, Haryana, Panchkula – respondent No.2, has also not solicited any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Estate Manager, Housing Board, Haryana, Panchkula – respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) within some specified time.

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Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Aman Bahri, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

In the light of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the prayer as made in the present writ petition, we dispose of the same without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, directing the Estate Manager, Housing Board, Haryana, Panchkula – respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the petitioner is found entitled to some benefit, the relief be released to her within a further period of four weeks.
