As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs. 3,20,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh and Twenty Thousand only) inclusive of the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is ordered to be paid to the LRs of appellant in proportionate manner as full and final settlement of his claim as the Insurance Company was exonerated by the Tribunal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the LRs of the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the LRs of appellant in proportionate manner as already awarded by the Tribunal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a demand draft for Rs.3,20,000/- in the name of the LRs of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall accrue on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue a proper receipt to learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company, after receipt of the said demand draft. The LRs of
