At the outset, both the learned counsels for the parties have submitted that the challenge in the present petition was for quashing of the impugned order dated 09.08.2017 whereby recovery was ordered and a show cause notice was also issued to the petitioner. They submitted that the aforesaid order has been withdrawn by the respondent Board and the enquiry proceedings have also been dropped and the recovery has also been waived and therefore the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the gratuity has been paid to the petitioner after the delay of 2½ years and he may be granted liberty to approach the respondent Board for raising his grievance for the grant of interest in accordance with law.

Liberty is granted as aforesaid.
