Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari seeking quashing of order dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-30), whereby her promotion as Superintendent Grade-II has been ordered as foregone due to non-joining at new proposed station in parent department within a period of one month from the date of issuance of promotion order. Further, prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to restore the order dated 02.01.2019 (Annexure P-18) and promotion be granted to the petitioner.

Written statement on behalf of respondent No.4 has been filed in

Court today and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the order sheets reveals that on 31.07.2019, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing i.e.10.02.2023, again there was no representation.

Today also no one has put an appearance on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that petitioner has lost interest in the present petition and is no more interested in pursuing the present case.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed in default.
