By way of present petition, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to make reference under Section 3(H) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (hereinafter referred to as '1894 Act') to the Principal Civil Court for adjudication of claim of the petitioner against the acquisition of his land situated in the village Samrala, District Ludhiana.

While referring to a letter dated 09.08.2019 issued by the Competent Authority Land Acquisition -cum- Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana (West), learned State counsel submits that the dispute already stands referred and the respective parties, including petitioner and respondent No.4, are appearing before the concerned Court and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
